Day 1 | In Transit

Depart for Oslo, Norway.

Day 2 | Oslo, Norway

Transfer to the Radisson Blu Scandinavia Hotel. Oslo. Later tonight, attend a Welcome Reception and get acquainted with your fellow travelers.

Day 3 | Oslo

Enrichment: Contemporary Norway.

Discovery: Oslo Overview & Ski Culture. Set off on a scenic drive to admire Oslo's top sites like the 19th-century Royal Palace and vibrant Aker Brygge Wharf, packed with restaurants, shops and people enjoying the waterfront. Continue to leafy Vigeland Park for a guided stroll to see statues by Norway's acclaimed sculptor Gustav Vigeland. After lunch, visit the Holmenkollen Ski Jump, where skiers have


tested their skills since 1892. Check out the latest high-tech jump, soak up sweeping city views and learn about Norway's 4,000-year history of Nordic and downhill skiing at the Ski Museum.

Free Time: Make your own plans for sightseeing and dinner. Your Travel Director can offer ideas.

Day 4 | Oslo

Discovery: Norwegian Art & Seafaring.

Norwegian painter Edvard Munch was one of the most influential figures of the Modernist movement. At the new MUNCH museum, view his celebrated masterpiece, "The Scream," and other works from his prolific, 60-year career. Afterward, delve into the amazing voyages of the great Norwegian explorer Thor Heverdahl at the Kon-Tiki Museum. Study his famous vessels, the balsawood raft Kon-Tiki and the totora-reed boat Ra II. which he used to cross

the Atlantic in 1970. Then it's time to head to the water yourself for a panoramic cruise on Oslofjord!

Free Time: Make time for a pleasant walk along the Harbour Promenade. This extensive waterfront path connects old and new areas of the city and takes you past striking, modern architecture like the sleek Opera House, Deichman Library and more.

Dine tonight at one of Oslo's fine restaurants.

Day 5 | Bergen

After breakfast, check out of the hotel and depart for Bergen by train.

Discovery: Bergen Railway. Today's route takes you on Europe's highest altitude railroad, where

splendid vistas unfold. Cross Hardangervidda, a plateau at more than 4,000 feet above sea level. After reaching the highest point, the train edges by lovely fjords, waterfalls and forests.


Arrive this afternoon and check in to the Radisson Blu Royal Hotel, Bergen.

Free Time: The rest of the day is at leisure.

Day 6 | Bergen

Enrichment: The Fjords of Norway.

Discovery: *Bergen.* Nestled by a sheltered harbor and surrounded by seven mountains, Bergen exudes a cozy charm. With your guide, explore the historic wharf, Bryggen, an important trading center for the medieval Hanseatic League.

The Midnight Sun

This beautiful and intriguing natural phenomenon occurs because of the Earth's tilt and its rotation relative to the sun. As the Earth orbits the sun, the angle of its axis — at 23.5 degrees — means that part of the planet will be closer to the sun. When the Northern Hemisphere is tilted at its maximum toward the sun, it's summertime there. During this season, as the Earth rotates on its axis each day, the Arctic Circle region is so far north that it remains continuously in the sun's light, experiencing consecutive, 24-hour periods of sunlight from mid-May to late July.

See Rosenkrantz Tower, Håkon's Hall, built by King Håkon in the 13th century, and other gems. Then visit the hilltop summer home of the revered Norwegian composer Edvard Grieg.

Free Time: Enjoy more of Bergen independently. This evening, savor delicious local dishes at a dinner in Bergen with your fellow travelers.

Day 7 | Myrdal | Aurlandsfjord | Voss district

Discovery: The Best of Norway. Relish a journey aboard the Flåm Railway from Myrdal along one of the world's steepest train routes, surrounded by incomparable scenery. Wind by snow-dusted peaks and pass through mountain tunnels on your way to the pristine Aurlandsfjord, a narrow branch of the Sognefjord, Norway's longest fjord. Cruise on this stunning waterway to Gudvangen, and then enjoy the Voss district's idyllic natural beauty on your return to Bergen.

Day 8 | Tromsø

After breakfast, check out of the hotel and fly to Tromsø, Norway's Arctic capital located about 220 miles north of the Arctic Circle.

Enrichment: Life in the Arctic Circle.


Discovery: *Tromsø Overview.* During the late spring and early summer, the sun never sets here due to Tromsø's position above the Arctic Circle and the Earth's tilted axis. Witness this unique phenomenon during your stay as land and sea are bathed in a soft, golden-red light all night

long! Tucked within fjords, islands and snow-capped mountains, Tromsø is closely connected to the untouched wilderness that surrounds it. Inhabited since the Ice Age, this area boasts a rich heritage from both the indigenous Sami people and the Norse people. On a guided tour, visit the Arctic Cathedral and ride a cable car up Floyfjellet Mountain for stellar views. Check in to the Radisson Blu Hotel, Tromsø.

Day 9 | Tromsø

Discovery: Nature of Northern Norway.

Find out more about arctic wildlife at Polaria, which features playful seals and an aquarium filled with northern species of fish. Then admire the gorgeous arctic and alpine flora that thrives in this northerly climate at a botanical garden.

northern Norway's oldest culture. Learn about northern Norway's oldest culture at the Arctic University Museum of Norway. View colorful traditional clothing and handicrafts, understand the historic importance of reindeer herding to the Sami people and listen to joik, their folk music based on chanting. During your visit, chat with members of the Sami community. Try fresh, authentic northern specialties at lunch.

AHI Connects: Arctic Dogsledding.

Visit a working kennel and gain insights about how the dogs are trained, then enjoy cuddling with these friendly husky puppies!

Day 10 | Tromsø

Discovery: *Tromsø Fjord Cruise.* Majestic coastal scenery abounds on a five-hour cruise today! While cruising in the bays, straights and fjords around Tromsø, stop at modern fish farms and small villages, and look for marine life in the clear waters of the shallows.

Free Time: Follow your own agenda in Tromsø. This evening, share favorite memories of your Norwegian adventure with your fellow travelers at a Farewell Dinner.



Day 11 | In Transit

Transfer **3** to the airport in Tromsø for the return flight **4** to your gateway city.


