



cafés and shops. On your route, taste delicious regional specialties and wines.

Free Time: Catch a complimentary shuttle from the ship to the city this afternoon and enjoy Strasbourg's luminous *marché de Noël*, France's oldest holiday market established in 1570.

Enrichment: German Holiday Traditions.

From Advent wreaths to Christmas baking, learn about cherished family customs shared at home. The ship departs Strasbourg late this evening.

Day 5 | Mannheim, Germany | Heidelberg

The ship arrives early in the port of Mannheim.

Discovery: Heidelberg Castle and Town.

Step inside red-walled Heidelberg Castle, which stands watch over the Neckar Valley, and see the immense wine barrel built in 1591, which once contained 34,342 gallons of wine! Then follow your guide on a pleasant walk in the Old Town and along the banks of the Neckar River. Relax over lunch at a traditional German

restaurant, where you'll feel the comfortable, friendly ambience known as *gemütlichkeit*.

Free Time: Spend some time on your own in Heidelberg's historic center.

Day 6 | Rüdesheim | Rhine Gorge

PYJ | Choose one of these excursions:

- Rüdesheim Tour. Board a tram that takes you down charming Drosselgasse and stop at the "Christmas Market of the Nations" with holiday items from around the world. At a captivating museum, be amazed by the incredible ingenuity and melodies of music boxes, player pianos and other restored mechanical musical instruments.
- Rhine Wine Tasting. Visit the tranquil Abbey of St. Hildegard and learn about the multitalented St. Hildegard of Bingen, a prominent woman in

the medieval church. Later, sample the region's fine wines in the old cellar of a local winery.

On the way to Cologne this afternoon, sail through the Rhine's most stunning scenery. Known as the Rhine Gorge, this gently curving, picturesque 40-mile stretch was designated a UNESCO World Heritage site for its historical, cultural and geological significance.

Before dinner tonight, gather for a Glühwein party with your fellow cruisers. If you haven't already tried it at one of the holiday markets, indulge in this warm concoction of cinnamon, cloves, citrus and wine, a wintertime classic!

Day 7 | Cologne

The ship arrives in Cologne early this morning.

Discovery: Cologne Walking Tour. The city's majestic cathedral, a UNESCO World Heritage site, is northern Europe's largest Gothic church. Topped by two filigreed spires, it was built over a period of more than 630 years. On a guided



walk, see landmarks along the old town's narrow lanes and admire the cathedral's grand interior.

Free Time: Take advantage of complimentary shuttles between the ship and the city center this afternoon. Shop for handcrafted mementos

Aachen was the imperial capital and favorite royal residence of Charlemagne (747-814), who also enjoyed its therapeutic hot springs. Visit the Aachen Cathedral, a UNESCO World Heritage site, featuring Charlemagne's richly decorated imperial chapel and his original throne. Walk in the historic center and spa area before finishing at the city's cheery Christmas market.

Free Time: Spend your afternoon at leisure. Tonight, celebrate your yuletide journey with your shipmates at a Farewell Reception and Dinner.

After breakfast, transfer 3 to the airport for the return flight to your gateway city.






