Day 1 | In Transit

Depart gateway city for Rabat, Morocco. 🌐

Day 2 | Rabat, Morocco

Upon arrival, transfer ➡ and check in to the Sofitel Rabat Jardin des Roses.

Kick off your Moroccan adventure during a Welcome Reception tonight.

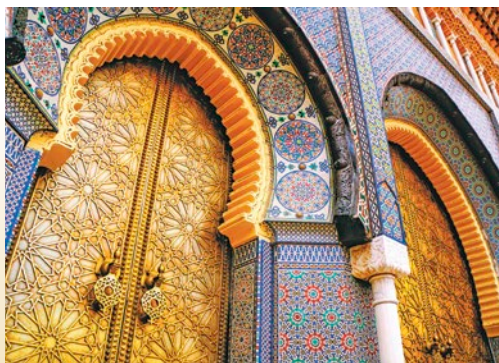
Day 3 | Rabat

Rabat Walking Tour. View the impressive architecture and gardens of the Royal Palace, the residence of Morocco's royalty. Next, visit Kasbah des Oudaias, a peaceful neighborhood with whitewashed houses. Continue to the striking Mausoleum of Mohammad V, the resting place of past kings, and gaze in wonder at the impressive Hassan Tower, rising above the ruins of its mosque. Cap off today's excursion at the Citadel of Chellah, which has been abandoned since the 1100s.

Day 4 | Rabat | Casablanca | Marrakech

After breakfast, depart for Marrakech. Stop in Casablanca to see the city's incredible sights.

Casablanca Discovery. Experience the vibe of Casablanca's central square, Place Mohammad V. Surrounding the square are examples of Mauresque architecture. Pause to admire the façade of the Church of the Sacred Heart. Settle in for lunch at Rick's Café, a re-creation of the timeless nightclub in the 1942 classic "Casablanca." Then visit the state-of-the-art Hassan II Mosque, nestled on Casablanca's coastline. The mosque is one of the largest places of worship on Earth!

Arrive in Marrakech and check in to your hotel.

Day 5 | Marrakech

Enrichment: Moroccan History. Learn about the country's fascinating history, from the Berber dynasty to modern-day Morocco.

Exploring the Monuments of Marrakech.

Today's adventure begins at the Saadian Tombs. This burial place of royals from the Saadi Dynasty features more than 100 tombs! Step into Marrakech's shaded, mesmerizing souks, a lively marketplace, and uncover local culture while passing merchants selling textiles,

clothing and handicrafts. Continue to the Palais Bahia, the “Palace of Brilliance.” This property is graced with luxurious apartments, courtyards, zellige mosaic floors and gardens. Early this evening, stand in awe before the Koutoubia Mosque, known for its stunning minaret, and experience the activity of Jemaa el-Fna, a gathering place and performance space for fire-eaters, acrobats, storytellers and musicians. This expansive main square is the beating heart of Marrakech and a great spot to witness day-to-day life. Appreciate the action from above at a rooftop café; then join your guide for a walk through the square. Enjoy a dinner of tantalizing Moroccan cuisine.

Day 6 | Marrakech

 **AHI Connects | Moroccan Cuisine and Arabic Calligraphy.** Launched in 2012, the nonprofit Amal Women’s Center helps disadvantaged women learn cooking skills, gain roles within the hospitality industry, and prepare for financial independence. During a cooking lesson, learn to make a selection of recipes — such as salads, bread, tagine and dessert. While your lunch is cooking,

enjoy a lesson on Arabic calligraphy. Try your hand at reproducing the beautiful patterns, lines and curves of this artistic expression.

Dar el Bacha Palace. Visit the Museum of Confluences at Dar el Bacha Palace. The beautiful palace was built for Pacha Thami El Glaoui who ruled over Marrakech from 1912 to 1956. Browse the informative exhibitions and note the fine woodwork, jade palm tree and lovely zellige tilework.

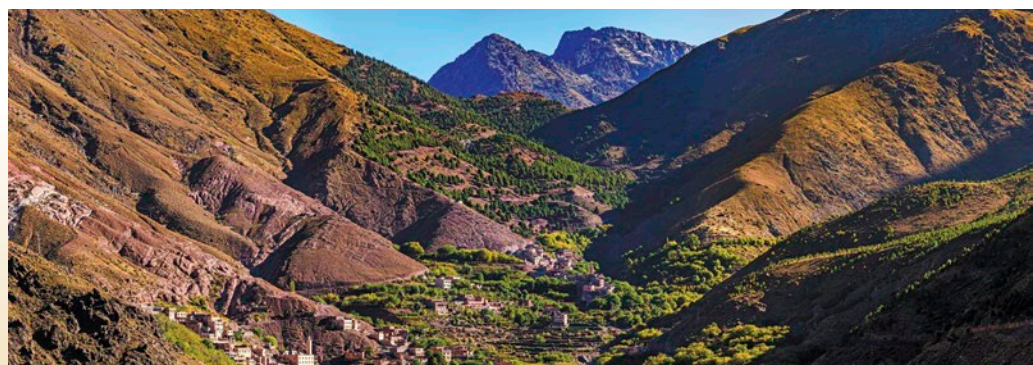
Day 7 | Atlas Mountains | Marrakech

Atlas Mountains. Journey through a dramatic landscape to the Atlas Mountains, North Africa’s highest mountain range. Visit a traditional Berber (Amazigh) settlement and meet a local family in their home. Over sweet mint tea and homemade bread, learn about rural living and the Berber culture and lifestyle. During your outing, relax over lunch accompanied by picturesque landscapes.

Day 8 | Marrakech

Gardens and Souks. Join a guided walking tour of Jardin Majorelle, an oasis bursting with fountains, flora and vivid cobalt architecture. Created by French artist Jacques Majorelle in

the 1920s, the garden was later purchased and restored by Yves Saint Laurent and his partner Pierre Bergé. After a garden stroll, visit the Yves Saint Laurent Museum. Opened in 2017, the property features a collection of the designer's haute couture, plus a library. Back in the buzzing souks, enjoy a tour with tastings of local products and learn about common spices and herbs used in everyday cooking.
