DISCOVERY

Sled Dogs. Interact with friendly pups at Mad Dogs & Englishmen – Sled Dog Expeditions. Learn about the history of dog sledding and how the canines are trained to work as disciplined sled dogs.

Boundary Ranch. Enjoy a visit to an authentic Canadian ranch nestled in the natural beauty of Kananaskis Valley. Then gather for a tasty barbecue lunch.

Columbia Icefield. At Columbia Icefield, board a special vehicle that carries you to the Athabasca Glacier. Your guide provides insight as you step onto the glacier's surface.

Athabasca River Float. Admire the Rockies from a unique vantage point while drifting along the Athabasca River, the very route once used by fur traders. Listen to tales of the area's history by an expert guide.

Athabasca Falls and Peyto Lake. Discover where the Athabasca River crashes in a powerful display. Next, enjoy the tranquil beauty of Peyto Lake amid mountains and forestland.

Treasures of Banff National Park. Explore the park's most magical sights, including Surprise Corner on Tunnel Mountain Drive, the fairy-tale "Castle of the Rockies" and Bow Falls. View the uniquely shaped hoodoo rocks, and see Lake Minnewanka and the abandoned ruins of Bankhead mining town.

Cave and Basin National Historic Site. Journey to the birthplace of the Canadian parks system. Witness two bubbling hot springs, and experience the site's interactive exhibits. Enjoy viewing the historic bathhouse and emerald waters of the basin.

Banff's Lakes. Travel to two of Banff's most beautiful lakes, intimate Moraine Lake and the "Jewel of the Canadian Rockies," Lake Louise. Enjoy a guided walk near Lake Louise's azure waters and embark on a gondola ride over unspoiled wilderness and wildlife.

ENRICHMENT

Life on a Canadian Ranch. Tour a typical Canadian Rockies ranch, and learn about the property's domestic animals and local wildlife.

Jasper Dark Sky Preserve. After an interactive session at Jasper's planetarium, step outside to witness the glorious night sky using the largest telescope in the Rockies. Also learn to take photos with personal cameras.

The Mounties. Enjoy an entertaining talk as a retired member of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police shares the history of the RCMP.
