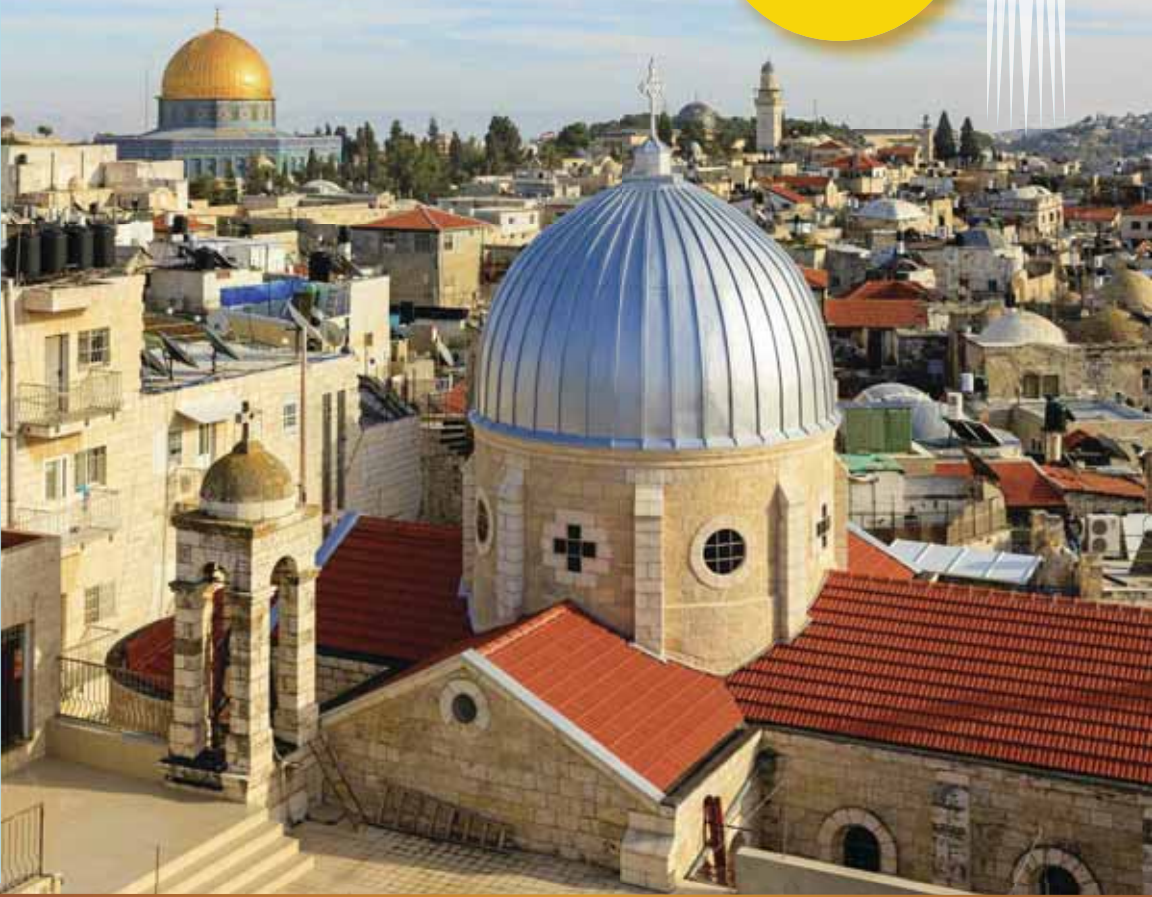

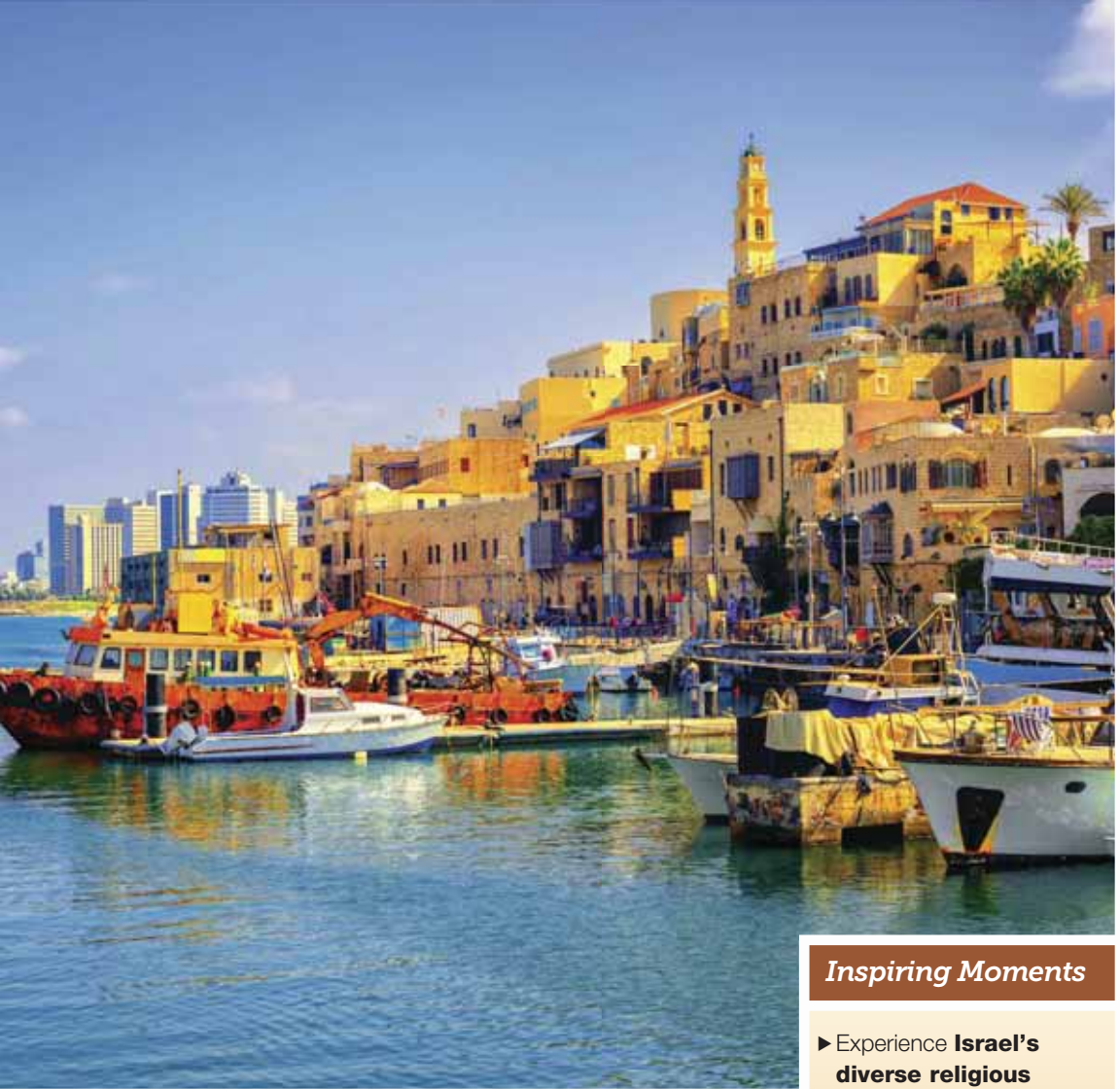

Tel Aviv

Discovery: Ancient Jaffa. Experience one of Israel’s most enchanting places. Revel in the captivating Old Town atmosphere as you stroll cobbled alleyways, browse the bustling flea market and visit with local artists.

Discovery: Neve Tzedek. Take a walking tour of the artsy Neve Tzedek neighborhood, known for its avant-garde design stores, fashion boutiques and handicraft shops. Neve Tzedek is one of Tel Aviv’s prettiest districts.

Free Time: During leisure time, visit a nearby restaurant for lunch or browse merchants’ stalls for bargains and treasures.

Discovery: Museum of the Jewish Diaspora. Beit Hatfutsot offers visitors a compelling historical account of the Jewish people. Learn about 2,500 years of history, from when the Jewish tribes were exiled from the land of Israel until current times.

Day 4

Tel Aviv | Caesarea | Akko | Tiberias

Discovery: The White City. Tel Aviv boasts the world’s largest collection of Bauhaus-style buildings with over 1,500 examples located throughout the city. Drive through this “White City” and admire the marvelous architecture.

Discovery: Mediterranean Coast. En route to Tiberias, visit Caesarea, an archeological park first settled in the fourth century B.C. View many of the city’s highlights including Herod’s grand Roman theater and the magnificent hippodrome, which once featured gladiator games and chariot racing. Gaze at Herod’s spectacular aqueduct and view the Crusader Wall and fortifications. During a multimedia presentation, learn about the region’s fascinating history.

Delight in local flavors during a group lunch.

Discovery: Ancient Akko. Visit the well-preserved, walled city of historic Akko. This old Arab locale near the Mediterranean Sea was a bustling port city for over 4,000 years. Today, the city's picturesque waterfront has magnificent stone buildings; beautiful archways; and a labyrinth of alleyways, churches and green-roofed mosques. While exploring the Old City, take note of its thick fortifications, imposing towers and splendid 18th-century ramparts. In Tiberias, check in to the Mizpe Hayamim.

Day 5

Tabgha | Capernaum | Golan Heights

Discovery: Upper Galilee and Capernaum.

Embark on a scenic cruise on the Sea of Galilee (weather permitting), and visit Tabgha, a fishing village on the northwest shore. Continue to the Mount of Beatitudes, believed by many to be the site of Jesus' Sermon on the Mount. In Capernaum, visit an ancient synagogue with

Jewish motifs, and see the House of Peter, a home where Jesus is believed to have lodged.

Discovery: A Taste of Olive Oil. Savor the buttery flavors of freshly pressed olive oil during a factory tour and learn how the oils are made. Taste local wines and enjoy lunch on the property.

Discovery: Golan Heights Winery. From cabernet sauvignon and merlot to chardonnay and sauvignon blanc, your taste buds will relish the flavors of local vintages during a wine tasting.

Day 6

Tiberias | Megiddo | Haifa | Jerusalem

Discovery: Tel Megiddo — A Focus on Archeology. Explore the archaeological mound of Megiddo, a fascinating UNESCO World Heritage site. These impressive ruins have more than 25 layers of settlements! See the fortified cities and walk through an underground tunnel. This Iron Age structure once supplied the city's residents with water from a nearby spring.

AHI Connects: Meet the People. Enjoy an authentic Druze lunch when a family welcomes you into their home. The Druze cuisine is characterized by special blends of spices such as turmeric, cumin, cinnamon and paprika.

Discovery: Mount Carmel. Haifa is Israel's third largest city and a renowned high-technology industrial center. From a terrace on Mount Carmel, revel in sprawling vistas of the city beyond. The pretty Bahá'í Gardens, which are comprised of 19 terraces, rest on the lower slopes of Mount Carmel.

Arrive in Jerusalem and check in to the David Citadel Hotel. This landmark hotel is located in the center of Jerusalem, near the Old City.

Enrichment: Is it Finally Time for a Peace Deal? Tonight, listen as an expert presents an assessment of Israeli-Palestinian relations during a fascinating lecture and discussion.

Day 7

Jerusalem

Discovery: In-depth Jerusalem. The ancient city of Jerusalem is the spiritual heart of three world faiths — Judaism, Islam and Christianity. Discover the many religious shrines, temples, churches and mosques housed in the Old City of Jerusalem. See Temple Mount and pause at the Western Wall. Walk along a portion of the Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. During your tour, enjoy stunning panoramic views from the Mount of Olives and explore the interpretive Davidson Center. Lunch on delectable falafels at a restaurant in

the Arab Quarter. This neighborhood is filled with narrow alleys and bustling souks overflowing with spices, mint tea, aromatic coffees, textiles and leather goods.

Free Time: During time at leisure, explore Jerusalem's many wonders and sites.

Day 8 B | L

Masada | Ein Bokek | Jerusalem

Discovery: Judean Desert Drama and a Sea of Salt. Spend a poignant morning at the site of Masada, an isolated flattop rock overlooking the Dead Sea. Then descend 1,378 feet below sea level to Ein Bokek on the shoreline of the Dead Sea, the deepest hypersaline lake in the world. Surrounded by a barren expanse of painted mountainous desert, the Dead Sea is fed by the River Jordan, which flows from the Sea of Galilee. Relax on the beach or enjoy a swim. Savor lunch with a view near the Dead Sea.

Day 9 B | D

Jerusalem

Discovery: A Poignant Monument. Yad Vashem is Israel's memorial and place of commemoration for the millions who perished in the Holocaust. Tour the exhibition halls and galleries, and see the Hall of Names, a memorial to the lives taken during the Holocaust.

Enrichment: A Survivor Speaks. Join a question-and-answer session with a Yad Vashem guide and hear a personal account of his/her experiences during World War II.



Free Time: Craft your own itinerary at Machane Yehuda, a bustling local market. Shop at open-air stalls, sample local specialties or browse the unique clothing and spices. Gather with your fellow travelers this evening for a Farewell Dinner and share your favorite stories and moments from your adventure in Israel.

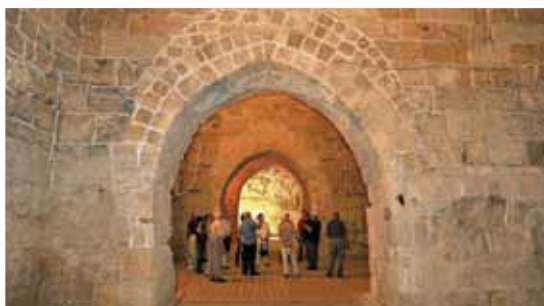

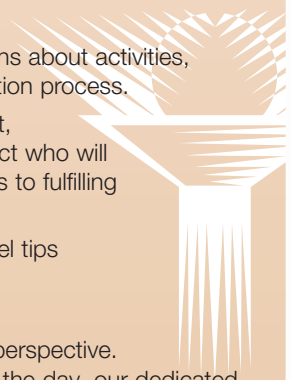
