

Later, in Parnell, Auckland's oldest suburb, meander through charming streets filled with restaurants, boutiques and specialty shops.

### Day 5 | Auckland | Dunedin

After breakfast, transfer to Auckland's domestic airport for your flight to Dunedin on the South Island. Upon arrival, check in to the hotel.

**Discovery:** *Dunedin's Old Town.* Dunedin takes pride in its rich Scottish heritage. On a guided walk, admire the city's elegant Scottish Edwardian and Victorian architecture. Begin in the Octagon, the eight-sided plaza, and stroll to see historic gems like the First Church, St. Paul's Cathedral and the Dunedin Railway Station, one of New Zealand's finest buildings.

### Day 6 | Dunedin

- Taieri Gorge Railway. On a four-hour train ride, marvel at the wild, beautiful and remote Central Otago countryside as the train snakes its way across the Taieri Plains and through the narrow Taieri Gorge via tunnels, bridges and viaducts.
- •Otago Peninsula's Wildlife. This enchanting area is a haven for diverse wildlife, such as fur seals, marine birds and the very rare yellow-eyed penguin. On a scenic coastal drive, delight in the rolling hills and sapphire waters. Visit the Royal Albatross Center, the world's only mainland breeding colony for this large seabird, to view several bird species. Hike to the beach to observe penguins waddling to their nests and sea lions lounging on the sand.

### Day 7 | Dunedin

**Free Time:** Spend the morning at leisure. If you'd like, catch a complimentary, round-trip shuttle to either Glenfalloch Woodland Gardens or Larnach Castle, two of Dunedin's top sites.

**Discovery:** *New Zealand Brew.* Speight's Brewery has been crafting refreshing ales and lagers since 1876. On a fun tour, learn how the beer is produced and savor some fresh samples.





### Day 8 | Dunedin | Queenstown

### **Discovery:** Scenic Drive to Queenstown.

Journey westward, admiring the rugged inland. Near Queenstown, take in the stunning shoreline of Lake Wakatipu, a narrow lake that zigzags through the mountains, and stop for photos.

**CAHI Connects:** Country Lunch. Enjoy lunch at a quaint lodge in a restored Victorian homestead.

### **Enrichment:** Extreme Sports in New

**Zealand.** Known as the "Adventure Capital of the World," Queenstown attracts thrill-seekers drawn to its exhilarating outdoor activities, including white-water rafting, bungee jumping, jet boating and sky diving. Learn more about the history of extreme sports in the region.

Arrive in Queenstown and check in to the hotel.

### Day 9 | Queenstown

**Discovery:** Safari of the Scenes. Director Peter Jackson, a native New Zealander, chose the ethereal natural beauty of his homeland to represent Tolkien's Middle-earth in his "Lord of the Rings" movies. Gaze over Wakatipu Basin at the mesmerizing landscape, then head along a historic gold mining road and try panning for gold.

**Free Time:** The afternoon is at leisure. For incredible, sweeping vistas, climb aboard the Skyline Gondola for a gentle ride up Bob's Peak.

### Day 10 | Queenstown
